



## **RAMKY Completes 2<sup>nd</sup> Largest STP in ASIA.**

Hyderabad December 12, 2008. Dr.Y.S.Rajasekhara Reddy, Hon'ble Chief Minister - Government of Andhra Pradesh will inaugurate 172 MLD STP (Sewage Treatment Plant) at Nagole, Hyderabad on 13 December 2008. Constructed by M/S Ramky Infrastructure Ltd, the flagship company of Ramky Group, This is the second largest STP in Asia based on UASB (Up-flow Anaerobic sludge Blanket Reactor Technology) which will treat 172000000 liters of sewage per day and generate about 1000 KW electricity per hour at its optimum capacity.

The project was awarded by HMWSSB under National River Action plan Assistance by National River conservation Directorate, Ministry of Environment and Forest, GOVT of India.” The project is worth of Rs.47 Cr. Ramky will also operate and maintain the plant for the next 5 years.
